- Caron Job – Yuba County One Stop

 - Father's Matter 6 week series has been successful so far.
- Kathleen Shenk – Youth for Change
 - Currently provide activities for Deferential Response (DR) families. However, they have now extended the opportunity for other families in the community. Activities include games and crafts for families with children 0-17 years of age. Are getting good attendance and have seen additional families within the community. Had 8-9 families attend the last activity.

Family First Prevention Services Act (FFPSA)

- Implementation team for the CPP meet on March 5th. They participated in a two-day meeting, with the first day being held virtually and the second day taking place in person at Youth for Change.
- The team discuss the purpose of the implementation team, the vision and mission and engaged in team building activities.
- The upcoming meeting is scheduled for the end of March. During this session, the team will focus on developing the road map, discussing the next steps and roles, and extending invitations to individuals with expertise in tribal engagement and lived experience.

Prevention Network

- Parent Education Ad Hoc (Amy-Molina)
 - Are moving forward with Triple P and the group met on March 5th. They are working on establishing a schedule for this spring and fall. It will be first offered at the Depot and childcare will be provided. Next series will be in Spanish at the Depot.
 - Parent Network: Met and have a workshop that just got approved, flyers will be going out shortly.
- Resource Planning Ad Hoc (Kathleen Shenk)
 - Since last meeting, no RFPs have been released for considerations by the group.
 - The group is currently exploring options for implementing a network referral system for the Public Health California Home Visiting program slots
 - Had an initial meeting with Ericka and Meredith, and for the portion of those available slots, will create a pipeline from some of the medically assisted treatment program and some of their clinical services for parents who have a child in the qualifying age group and make a referral process from Peach Tree
 - Their main focus is on identifying vulnerable populations who can benefit from this program.
 - Currently are in the final stages of discussion with Public Health.

Displaced Youth Multi-Disciplinary Team Update (DYMDT)

- Referral list and caseload is growing.
- The collaboration with YCOE has thrived.
- Have seen clients who are making steps towards stabilization.

April Child Abuse Prevention Month Toolkit Draft (Jessica Garcia – HHSD)

- An overview was given on the external/internal outreach activities planned for the month of April.

External outreach activities include:
