## Prevention Network

- All Children Thrive (ACT) (Cathy LeBlanc)
  - Presenting the Community Action Plan to the Board of Supervisors on December 12, 2023 at 9:00 a.m.
  - Would like to go back and present the Community Action Plan again in February, since that's when the BOS does their budgeting.
  - Want to continue the resource center, have spoken to SYBH and are helping with early intervention and are hoping some funding from that goes to the resource center.
- Parent Education Ad Hoc (Theresa Hioki on behalf of Amy-Molina)
  - The first Parent Partners workshop was held in November and had 18 attendees. It was a success and were able to connect parents to resources.
  - Had a parent project facilitator meeting, so all trained facilitators in Yuba and some from Sutter came together to see how they are doing. More collaboration between agencies and schools.
  - Triple P parenting training for 12 and up is coming up next and 12 and under is the following week. More parenting classes coming out.
  - Looking in to OCAP grant Road to Resilience and talking to partners to see how they can help with the parenting education piece.
- Resource Planning Ad Hoc (Kathleen Shenk)
  - Road to Resilience funding – was previously invoiced with Placer county and is very data heavy. Data collection and analysis is very important for all partners to have in place before going forward. Spoke to Ericka about bringing a group together to use the matrix.
  - Youth for Change spoke to Sutter County for the children in youth behavioral health initiative round 3. Youth for Change applied to continue to expand the home visiting program. Hoping to hear soon from the state.

## Displaced Youth Multi-Disciplinary Team Update (DYMDT)

- Have done six home visits in the last two weeks. Reconnecting families with HHSD HSP program.
