- ACT – Cathy
  - Youth are meeting twice a month with ACT Youth Coordinator and making good progress with building trust and getting to know each other.
  - Training for staff is scheduled for later in July on how to best utilize social media with the goal of increased recruitment.

- The ACT Community meetings continue monthly on the 4th Thursday of each month. Asset Maps began for the community's identified concerns for transportation (this map began earlier), health and resources, housing, social cohesion and trust. Additionally, an asset map for early childhood programs is also being developed.
- July's meeting will have the teams work on Action Plans for the identified concerns.
